3. Venue

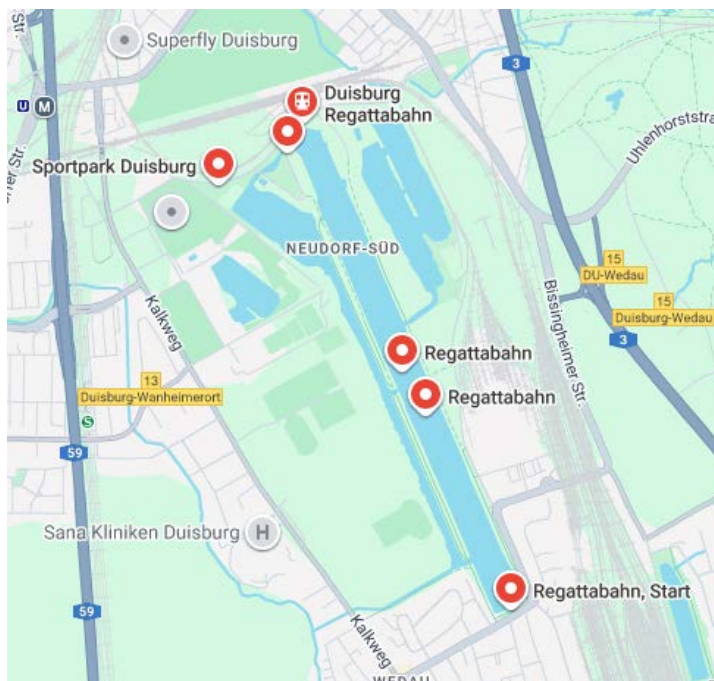

The Regatta Course is an artificial rowing/canoeing lake in Duisburg, Germany. The Course was built in 1935 and has hosted numerous international watersports events since its construction.

In year 2005 Duisburg was the host of World Games including Canoe Polo. Including the 1983 World Rowing Championships. It has also served as host of the ICF Canoe Sprint World Championships 1987, 1995, 2007, 2013 and 2023. The Lake is 2,150m long and 135m wide and up to 9m deep.

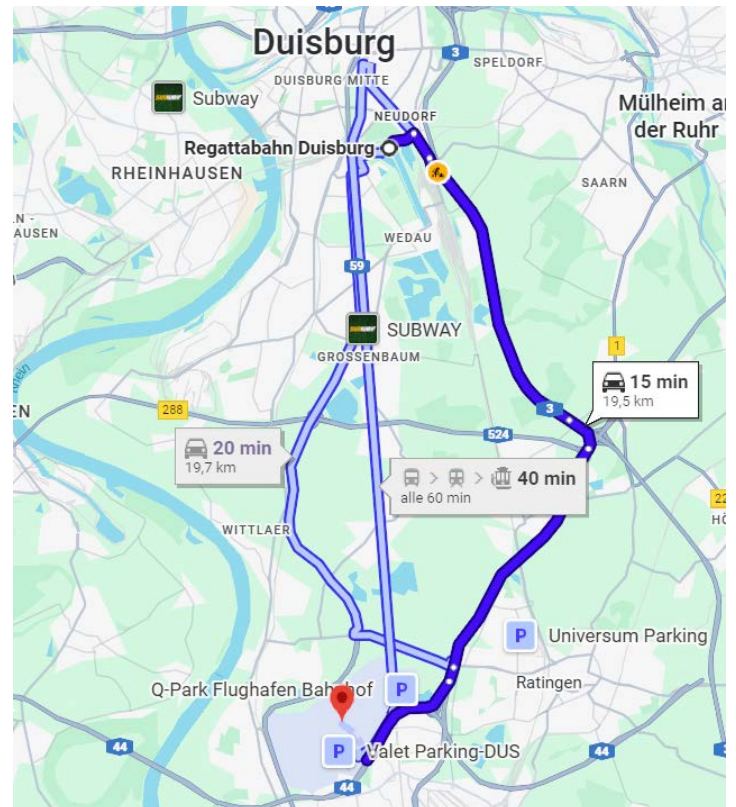


4. Venue accessibility

Düsseldorf Airport

Located in Düsseldorf, there is an International Airport with connections to 174 destinations.

20 kilometres away from the Duisburg, Regattabahn where the event is holding. It is 25 minutes away from the venue by car. There will be an information point and an opportunity for shuttle service, contact the HOC for details.



Duisburg, Train Station

Located in Duisburg, there is a railway station, with good connections to Cologne Airport, Frankfurt Airport, Brussels Airport and Amsterdam Schiphol.

The railway station Duisburg is 5 Kilometres (10 minutes by car) away from the venue.



The venue of the World Championships 2026 is really close to the main highways, especially the highways from the main Airports (5 minutes by car). Close to the venue there are public parking slots (5 minutes by walk).

VISA

All participants are kindly requested to contact the German Embassy or Consulate in their home country. Be aware that visa applications may take some time to process. Please send requests for supporting documents to your visa application to the Organising Committee without any delay once specified by the German Embassy or Consulate. We will then contact the German Embassy in your home country directly.

6. Accommodation

We offer hotels in various categories at the following prices.

All hotels are located in Duisburg and are connected to the competition venue by a shuttle service.

Categorie 1:	105, - € per night and person 136 beds available	level: 2 stars	5-10 minutes by shuttle
Categorie 2:	115, - € per night and person 490 beds available	level: 3 stars	5-10 minutes by shuttle
Categorie 3:	135, - € per night and person 469 beds available	level: 4 stars	5-10 minutes by shuttle

Each room will accommodate two persons and includes breakfast.

There is an option to offer food at the venue:

- Lunch: 32,50 €
- Lunch and dinner box: 39,50 €

It is necessary that the order and payment of the food must be paid prior to the event at the August 10th 2026.

7. Transportation

Airport transfer:

We will send out Information in the second bulletin.

There will be a special mail contact for logistics.

Shuttle bus will be provided between team official hotels and the competition venue. Teams booking hotels outside the officially offered ones will not be connected to the shuttle service.

8. Participation fee

The participation fee for the 2026 ICF Canoe Polo World Championships, payable by all athletes, coaches, team staff and team leaders irrespective of actual arrival and departure dates will be:

€ 285 (EUR)

for the entire nine-day (9) access period of 12th September 2026 – 20th September 2026.

The accreditation desk will be fully open on the 12th September.

By prior arrangement, pick-up of accreditations can be arranged on the 11th of September – please contact the HOC: booking@vfw-kanupolo.de

All participation fees must be payable to the HOC before the issue of any accreditation passes.

The participation fee includes the following services:

- Accreditation pass
- Usage of the training and competition venue.
- Opening and Closing ceremonies.
- Kayak and equipment storage.
- Free venue WIFI.
- Medical care at the venue.
- Security on the venue.
- Drinking water
- Shuttle service between team hotel and venue (for official HOC offered hotels)

The participation fee does not include offsite meals and accommodation.

9. Kayak rental

- 1) There will be carbon fibre kayaks available for rental.
- 2) This must not be an individual approach. The designated team leader must request the number of kayaks required for his/her team/s.
- 3) The costs will be specified in Bulletin 2.
- 4) All kayaks will be in good condition with bumpers and footrests fitted and comply with ICF Canoe Polo rules.
